Companion Bears

Materials

50gms double knitting yarn (approx)
small amount of black for eyes & nose.

Safety standard Fibre filling
3.50m crochet hook
ribbon

Options

lavender bag in-lummy.
butterfly.

Tip

mark start of rounds with contrast thread or stitch marker (makes counting easier)

Abbreviations

sc - single crochet

ss - slip stitch

dc tog - Insert hook into front of next 2 stitches draw loop through all 3 stitches (dec).

Head

Rnd 1 make 6sc into magic ring (6st)

Rnd 2 2sc into each st (12st)

Rnd 3 * 1sc into first st, 2sc into next st^{*}
rep from * to end (18st)

Rnd 4-5 1sc in each st (18st)

Rnd 6 1sc into next 2st, 2sc into next st^{*}

- rep from * to end (24st)
- 2nd 7-8 1sc into each st (24st)
- 2nd 9. 1sc into next 7st, 2sc into next 10st, 1sc into next 7st (34st)
- 2nd 10 * 1sc into next st, 2sc into next st
rep once more. 1sc into next 25st
1sc into next 2st 2sc in next st
1sc (38st)
- 2nd 11 1sc in next 11st, 2sc in next st
* 1sc in next 2st, 2sc in next st*
rep 4 times more, 1sc into next
11st (44st)
- 2nd 12-18 1sc in each st (44st)
- 2nd 19 1sc, dc2tog, 1sc in next 2st, dc2tog
1sc in next 30st, dc2tog 1sc in
next 2st, dc2tog, 1sc (40st)
- 2nd 20 1sc in next 11st, dc2tog, 1sc in next
2st, dc2tog, 1sc in next 6st
dc2tog, 1sc in next 2st, dc2tog, 1sc
in next 11st (36st)
- 2nd 21 1sc in each st (36st)
- 2nd 22 * 1sc in next 4st, dc2tog, * rep to end
30st
- 2nd 23 * 1sc in next 3st, dc2tog * rep to end (24st)
- 2nd 24 * 1sc in next 2st, dc2tog * rep to end (18st)

STUFF HEAD WITH FIBRE FILL

- 2nd 25 * 1sc in next st dc2tog * rep to end 12st
- 2nd 26 dc2tog around 6st.
close gap by threading yarn
through all sts.

Embroider eyes over rows 9-10.
+ nose over rds 1-3 add mouth



Body

- Rnd 1 6sc unto magic ring (6st)
- Rnd 2 2sc unto each st (12st)
- Rnd 3 *2sc unto first st, 1sc unto next st* rep from * to end (18st)
- Rnd 4 *2sc unto first st, 1sc unto next 2st* rep from * to end (24st)
- Rnd 5-7 1sc in each st 24st.
- Rnd 8 1sc in first st, 2sc in next st, *1sc in next 3st 2sc in next st* rep from * to last 2st, 1sc in each (30st)
- Rnds 9-10 1sc in each st (30st)
- Rnd 11 *1sc in next 4st, 2sc in next st* rep to end (36st)
- Rnd 12-13 1sc in each st (36st)
- Rnd 14 *1sc in next 5st, 2sc in next st* rep to end (42st)
- Rnd 15-17 1sc in each st 42st.
- Rnd 18 1sc in next 8st, 2sc in next st, *1sc in next 4st, 2sc in next st* rep to last 8st, 1sc in each st (48st)
- Rnd 19-22 1sc in each st (48st)
- Rnd 23 1sc in next 3st, dc 2tog, *1sc in next 6st, dc 2tog* rep 4 times more 1sc in last 3st (42st)
- Rnd 24 1sc in each st 42st.
- Rnd 25 1sc in next 4st, dc 2tog, *1sc in next 9st, dc 2tog* rep from * twice more, 1sc in next 3st (38st)
- Rnd 26 1sc in next 3st, dc 2tog, *1sc in next 8st, dc 2tog* rep from * twice more 1sc in next 3st (34st)

Ears! (make 4)

Row 1: make 6sc into magic ring
(do not join) (6st)

Row 2: 1ch. 1sc into next st, 2sc into
next 4 st, 1sc (10 st)

Row 3: 1ch 2sc into next st ^ 1sc into
next 2 st^{*} rep twice more (14st)
fasten off.

make up

Place two ears WS together join
yarn to one corner by pushing
hook through both ears.

1ch, make sc around by pushing through
both ears to join top of ears (semi-
circle) Ss into bottom of semi-circle
to join rep with other ear.

Sew to head, over rnds 17-18.

Tip you can make up/join ears tog.
by using the working yarn of ear
3 & 4 - Saves joining on again.

Rnd 27 1sc in next 3st dc2tog, *1sc in next
7st, dc2tog*, rep from* twice more
1sc in next 2st (30st)

Rnd 28 1sc in each st (30st)

Rnd 29 *1sc in next 3st, dc2tog* rep to end
(24st)

Rnd 30 1sc in next 2st, dc2tog* rep to end
(18st)

STUFF BODY - ADD LAVENDER BAG IF
DESIRED

Rnd 31 *1sc in next st, dc2tog* rep to end (12st)

Rnd 30 dc2tog around (6st)

ADD MORE STUFFING, Thread yarn
through all sts

Legs (make 2)

Rnd 1. 6sc into magic ring (6st)

Rnd 2 2sc into each st (12st)

Rnd 3 *2sc into first st, 1sc in next st* rep
to end (18st)

Rnd 4 *2sc into first st 1sc into next 2st*
rep to end (24st)

Rnd 5-6 1sc in each st (24st)

Rnd 7 1sc in first 4st, dc2tog 8 times
1sc in last 4st (16st)

Rnd 8-21 1sc in all st (16st)

Fasten off stuff & sew across
ends so foot shaping is on
top.

Arms

- Rnd 1 6sc into magic ring (6st)
Rnd 2 2sc into each st (12st)
Rnd 3 *2sc into first st 1sc into next st¹⁰
rep to end (18st)
Rnd 4-6 1sc in each st (18st)
Rnd 7 dc 2tog, 1sc in next 14st dc 2tog
(16st)
Rnd 8 dc 2tog, 1sc in next 12st dc 2tog
(14st)
Rnd 9-21 1sc in each st (14st)

Fasten off, stuff, sew across row
ends so shaping matches

make up

Sew head to body over rounds 1-4
of body - so that face shaping
faces forward

Attach arms & legs (in seated
position)

Add ribbon round neck or
head -

make butterfly & attach to hand.

B is for Butterfly

This fluttery friend would be the perfect embellishment for hats, hair clips, purses and totes, wall decor, crib mobiles, and more! I can see this adorning a variety of [crochet](#) kids items and of course its representing the second letter of my Animal [Alphabet](#) Afghan!

Materials:

- Worsted weight yarn in any color. I used Lion Brand Vanna's Choice in Raspberry and Chocolate.
- Size G Crochet Hook (the bigger the hook the bigger the appliqué and vice versa)
- Tapestry needle

SC = Single Crochet

Crochet Butterfly Applique [Pattern](#):

Chain 8, SC in second chain from hook, chain 4, skip one stitch in foundation chain and join with a SC, SC in next two foundation chain stitches, chain 4, skip one stitch and join with a SC to last chain.

Now working on other side of chain, SC in first stitch, chain 6, skip one stitch in foundation chain and join with a SC to next stitch, SC in next two foundation chain stitches, chain 6, skip one stitch and join with a SC to last chain.

Round 2: SC to bring you over to the first chain loop, make 4 SC in chain loop, make 2 SC to bring you over to the next loop, make 4 SC in next chain loop, SC to bring you over to the loops on the other side, make 6 SC in first loop, make 2 SC to bring you over to the last loop, make 6 SC in loop.

Round 3: Slip Stitch to bring you to the stitches on first loop, make 2 SC in next 2 stitches, chain 2, SC in second chain (this makes the point on each wing), 2 SC in last two stitches on the first loop, Slip stitch in next two to bring you to the stitches on the next loop, make 2 SC in next 2 stitches, chain 2, SC in second chain, 2 SC in last two stitches on the first loop, Slip stitch to bring you to the next loop, 2 SC in first 3 stitches on loop, chain 2, SC in second chain, 2 SC in last 3 stitches on loop, Slip stitch in next two to bring you to the last loop, 2 SC in first 3 stitches on loop, chain 2, SC in second chain, 2 SC in last 3 stitches on loop, Slip stitch to join.

Fasten off leaving long tail to sew onto blanket.

With brown yarn surface crochet up the middle and when you get to the end make 3 chains. Fasten off and attach yarn to the top and make another 3 chains (these will be the antennae). Make sure to knot the ends so they don't unravel!
