



Worry Worms

English Pattern - Crochet Hook 4.00 mm

Chain 32

Work 4 “double crochet” in second chain from hook and in each chain to end.

Work 10 “treble” in last stitch for face. Join with slip stitch.

Work 1 “double crochet” in next stitch, 2 “double crochet” in next stitch. Repeat around to give firm edge.

Finish off leaving long thread.

Use end to make sure body is nice and firm at head.

Crochet google eyes. Use 2.00 crochet hook.

Into “magic circle” - work 2 “double crochet” and join with slip stitch. Work centre of eye with a little bit of black wool. Attach to worm.

To neaten, use ends of wool from body to cover up white and black wool.

I am a little worry worm,
Keep me close and
keep me near,
And I will bring you cheer.

Gauge is not important but will depend on the thickness
of your double knitting wool

I now use 4ply wool for googly eyes

Elephant Face

English Pattern - Crochet Hook 3.50 mm

Worked in continuous rounds - do not join. Use stitch marker to count rounds.

Into Magic Circle - Chain 3

15 "Treble" into Ring, slip stitch to top of chain. Close circle.

Round 2 - Chain 3

2 "treble" into each stitch

Slip stitch in top of chain to finish off.



Ears

Into magic Magic Circle Chain 3

9 Treble into ring. Close circle but do not join

Row 2

Chain 3 - Turn

1 Treble into same space

2 Treble in next stitch

1 Treble in next stitch

*2 Treble in next stitch

2 Treble in next stitch

1 Treble in next stitch* - Repeat to end

Fasten Off

Trunk

Chain 15

Double Crochet, Treble, Slip stitch,
Treble, Double Crochet into
second chain from hook.

Double crochet in next stitch

1 HDC in next stitch

2 HDC in next stitch

2 Treble in next stitch

2 Treble in next stitch

2 Treble in next stitch

1 Treble in each chain across.

1 Treble, 1 DC, 1 slip stitch in last
stitch.

Fasten Off

Crochet google eyes. Use 2.00 crochet hook.

Into "magic circle" - work 2 "double
crochet" and join with slip stitch. Work
centre of eye with a little bit of black
wool. Attach to face.

To neaten, use ends of wool to cover up
white and black wool,

I am Nellie the Elephant.
I am here to make you smile.
Hold me tight and keep me close.
And I will bring you cheer.

Gauge is not important but will depend on the thickness
of your double knitting wool

I now use 4ply wool for googly eyes

I have not tested this pattern since typing from my original notes



Arms

Chain 8

DC in 2nd chain

DC to end (7)

DC along other side of chain.

Fasten Off

Heart

Rear of Face

Work Rows 1 - 4 of basic face pattern - 30 stitches.

Slip stitch to front, leaving one row of front to give a nice rim to face.

Hug Face

English Pattern - Crochet Hook 3.50 mm

Worked in continuous rounds - do not join.

Use stitch marker to count rounds.

Into magic Circle -

Round 1

1 Double Crochet in each stitch (12)

Round 2

2 Double Crochet in next stitch, 1 Double Crochet in next stitch - Repeat around (18)

Round 3

2 Double Crochet in next stitch, DC in next 2 sts - Repeat around (24)

Round 4

2 Double crochet in next stitch, DC in next 3 sts (30)

Round 5

2 Double crochet in next stitch, DC in next 4 sts (36)

Fasten Off

Crochet google eyes. Use 2.00 crochet hook.

Into “magic circle” - work 2 “double crochet” and join with slip stitch. Work centre of eye with a little bit of black wool. Attach to face.

Here's a gift to cheer your day
Just for you to take away.
Keep it close, warm and snug,
In case you need a hug.

Gauge is not important but will depend on the thickness of your double knitting wool. Adjust pattern if necessary.

I now use 4ply wool for googly eyes

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Octopus Twiddles

English Pattern - Crochet Hook 3.50 mm

Worked in continuous rounds - do not join. Use stitch marker to count rounds.

Into "Magic Circle" -

Round 1

1 Double Crochet in each stitch (12)

Round 2

2 Double Crochet in next stitch, 1 Double Crochet in next stitch - Repeat around (18)

Round 3

2 Double Crochet in next stitch, DC in next 2 sts - Repeat around (24)

Round 4

2 Double Crochet in next stitch, DC in next 3 sts (30)

Double Crochet in next 8 stitches

Turn Work - Double Crochet in next 8 stitches - do not fasten off but



Tentacles

Chain 25

4 Double Crochet in each chain to end
Double Crochet in same space as first stitch

Double Crochet in next stitch
Chain 25

Continue for each tentacle.

Crochet google eyes. Use 2.00 crochet hook.

Make "magic circle" - work 2 "double crochet" and join with slip stitch. Work centre of eye with a little bit of black wool. Attach to face.

Rear of Face

Work Rows 1 - 4 of basic face pattern - 30 stitches.

Slip stitch to front, leaving one row of front to give a nice rim to face.

Gauge is not important but will depend on the thickness of your double knitting wool. Adjust pattern if necessary.

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Basic Face Pattern - A few ideas

English Pattern - Crochet Hook 3.50 mm

Worked in continuous rounds - do not join.
Use stitch marker to count rounds.

Make magic Circle

Round 1

One Double Crochet in each stitch (12)

Round 2

Two Double Crochet in next stitch, 1 Double Crochet in next stitch - Repeat around (18)

Round 3

Two Double Crochet in next stitch, DC in next 2 sts - Repeat around (24)

Round 4

Two Double Crochet in next stitch, DC in next 3 sts (30)

Round 5

Two Double Crochet in next stitch, DC in next 4 sts (36)

Fasten Off



Rear of Face

Work Rows 1 - 4 of basic face pattern - 30 stitches.

Slip stitch to front, leaving one row of front to give a nice rim to face.

Crochet google eyes. Use 2.00 crochet hook.

Make "magic circle" - work 2 "double crochet" and join with slip stitch. Work centre of eye with a little bit of black wool. Attach to face.



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Knitted Puppets - Basic Pattern and a few ideas.

No 11 or 3 3/4 Needles.

Cast on 20 Stitches

Garter Stitch 2 rows

Begin with Knit row - Stocking Stitch 10 rows.

Break Yarn - Join with face colour

Stocking Stitch 6 Rows

Break yarn - Join Hair Colour

Stocking stitch four rows

Next Row - Knit two together to end.

Draw yarn through all stitches left.

Join row ends and turn right side out.

Use your imagination.

**Gauge is not important but will depend on the thickness
of your double knitting wool. Adjust pattern if necessary.**

I now use 4ply wool for features.
